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Modern Concept of Administration and its Islamic Bases

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Abstract:

Man is a collectivist and social creature for whom it is impossible to live without society. But the survival of a society in itself depends on social discipline and arrangements. The modern concept of social order is the concept of statehood and government. And the government is incomplete in itself without the modern concept of administration. The Lack of good governance and administration, brings a society to the brink of destruction. In such a case, human life cannot be easy, nor can the collective balance of the society be maintained. The solution to this problem is the establishment of such social arrangements and institutions that do not determine and protect the individual and collective rights of the people, but only encourage people to social struggle.

Therefore, the existence of administration is inevitable in the concept of collectivity of Islam. Islam has determined the duties of both the ruler and the public and has provided an excellent state administration.
