Hazrat Hatib said to Hazrat Hatib, "If your master is the Messenger of Allah, then why did your Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) not pray against his people at that time when his people expelled him from his own city?" Hazrat Hatib said: Regarding Isa bin Maryam, you yourself say that he was the Messenger of Allah, then when his people intended to give him peace, why did he not give him bad dua? Even Allah raised them to the sky. Muqaqas was greatly impressed by this resounding answer and said:

’احسنت! انت حكيم جاء من عند حكيم.^{xvi}

"You have given a good answer. You are wise and you have come from the wise."

Imam Ibn-e-Qayyim (751 AH) narrated the conversation between Muqoqs and Hazrat Hatib, which is as follows:

Hatib: "A person (Pharaoh) has passed before you (on this earth) who considered himself to be the supreme Lord. Allah made him a lesson for the last and last. At first, he took revenge from the people through him, then himself. Make it a target of revenge or take a lesson from others, so that others take a lesson from you.

Muqoqs: "We have a religion that we cannot leave until a better religion is found."

Hatib: We invite you to Islam, which Allah has made sufficient for all other religions. Look! When the same Prophet (peace be upon him) called the people (to Islam), the Quraysh proved to be the most strict against him, the Jews were the most hostile and the Christians were the closest. By my age! Just as Moses (A.S.) gave good news to Jesus (A.S.), so Jesus (A.S.) gave good news to Muhammad (PBUH), and we invite you to the Holy Qur'an just as you invite the people of the Torah to the Gospel. A nation that receives a prophet becomes its ummah and it becomes necessary for it to obey that prophet, and you have fulfilled the covenant of that prophet, and then we do not stop you from the religion of Christ, but we are the same. They order.

Muqaqs: I considered the case of this Prophet ﷺ, and I saw that he does not command anything that he dislikes and does not forbid anything that he likes. He is neither a misguided magician nor a false priest. It is a sign that they reveal the hidden and inform the whispering, I will consider further.”^{xvii}

It is clear from the dialogue between Hazrat Tatab (d. 30 AH) and Muqaqs that the Messenger of Allah ﷺ paid special attention to the training of the Companions whom he sent to other nations to call and preach. But he arranged that the Sahabi, may Allah be pleased with him, should be familiar with the language of that nation, secondly, he should be familiar with their culture, customs and traditions, and thirdly, he should be familiar with their religion.
